


## THE EMPTY TOMB



The people were \*Matt. 5:27-28


ASTONISHED at his doctrine.

He shocked the religious community by opening blind eyes, deaf ears... and healing lepers. *He even raised the dead!* (See Matt. 8 & 9.)



He publicly attacked the religious system, knowing it would bring about His death.



Ye serpents, ye generation of vipers (snakes), how can ye escape the damnation of hell? (See Matt. 23.)



Judas agreed to betray the Creator of the universe for only 30 pieces of silver. At the last supper, Jesus explained how His crucifixion would be the last blood sacrifice for sins, eliminating the priesthood. Jesus Himself would become God's permanent High Priest.



Man could now come straight to God because of His final sacrifice on the cross for our sins. But his disciples didn't understand.

Later in the Garden of Gethsemane, Jesus prayed in great sorrow. His sweat was like great drops of blood.

When sentenced to death, the angels of God watched in horror.




Never before had anyone dared to strike their Creator. But they were not permitted to defend Him. He must complete His mission.

Then Jesus was taken to the Roman governor, Pontius Pilate. Art THOU the king of the Jews? Thou sayest


Pilate found no fault in Him.








Israel rejected their Messiah, and Pilate ordered his death.

The whip tore away flesh, spurting blood.

Muscles were sliced wide open.

Most victims died from the beating.

They mocked Him with a purple robe and a crown of thorns.



carried a 100 pound cross 650 yards to the place of execution.

With His flesh in ribbons, He



gouged His torn, dehydrated body. Only a miracle kept Him alive!

"I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair." (Issiah 50:6a)



Isaiah said: "His visage was so marred more than any man." (Isaiah 52:14a)

They nailed Him to the cross, and drove rusty spikes into His wrists.



Jesus shed His blood so every sin ever committed could be forgiven.



Medical view of His suffering by G. Bradley, M.D.

This was the most agonizing death man could face... He had to support Himself in order to breathe... The flaming pain of the spikes hitting the median nerve in the wrists explodes up His arms, into His brain and down His spine.

The spike burning through the nerves of the feet jerks His body erect, then the leg muscles convulse and drive His body downward... beating Him against the cross. Exhaustion, shock, dehydration and paralysis destroy the victim.



Just before He died, Jesus shouted... "<u>IT IS FINISHED!</u>"

The penalty for the sins of all mankind had been paid in full.


Now anyone could be saved by putting their faith in Jesus Christ. Three days after the Lord was buried, He arose from the dead.




Jesus <u>DEFEATED</u> Satan, and conquered death and hell.






